Day of Surgery



Before you arrive:

- Make sure you follow any fasting instructions you have been given previously
- Take your usual medications as normal (with a small sip of water), unless advised otherwise by your doctor
- Bring all medications in their original containers with you
- If you wear glasses, bring a case to put them in
- Remove any nail polish
- Remove all jewellery (you may wear your wedding band if it is difficult to remove)
- Before you arrive, please shower or bathe and wash your hair
If your procedure involves any part of your face or eye, wash your face thoroughly with your usual face soap – Do NOT wear any face moisturiser, cream or make-up
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing and flat shoes – you may be required to change into a hospital gown (you do not need to bring pyjamas or a dressing gown)
- Bring the original copy of your completed paperwork (if you did not return it by post)
- Bring your Medicare card
- Bring your health fund membership card
- Bring your payment (if applicable)
- Bring some reading material if you wish (TVs and complimentary WiFi are available in waiting areas)
- Make sure that you have a responsible adult/carer who can accompany you home after your procedure and you can provide us with their contact details
- Give your carer a copy of the contact details for RiverCity Private Hospital, including instructions on how to find us and where to park (see over page)

When you arrive:

- Let us know if you have any mobility issues and require assistance
- Let us know if you have any existing skin wounds, cuts or abrasions

If you are unable to attend your scheduled procedure (e.g. you are ill), please notify us immediately on (07) 3736 3010.

Getting here

Car: Conveniently located only 2.5 kilometres west of Brisbane's CBD, we are easy to reach by car. There is a multi-level carpark with approximately 50 parking spaces on-site (4-hour parking limit).

Public transport: Bus route 470 stops on Milton Road (stop 10) opposite RiverCity Private Hospital. Alternatively, Auchenflower Railway Station is a 5-minute walk away. After your surgery, you will need assistance getting home – please arrange for a responsible adult to accompany you home.

Disability access: For people with limited mobility, the multi-level carpark provides easy access to the day surgery reception.
